

# DISTRICT #4'S "RUHLE OF THE WEEK"

This week's question:

I turned to the right after overrunning 1<sup>st</sup> base which means I cannot be tagged out while returning to 1<sup>st</sup> base. Correct?

Answer: WRONG!

Rule book reference 7.08(j)

Let's make one thing clear, it does not matter which way you turn after overrunning 1<sup>st</sup> base.

The deciding factor is: did you make an "attempt to advance to 2<sup>nd</sup> base?" If "in the judgment of the umpire" you made an "attempt to advance" you are in jeopardy and could be tagged out.
